17th June 2016

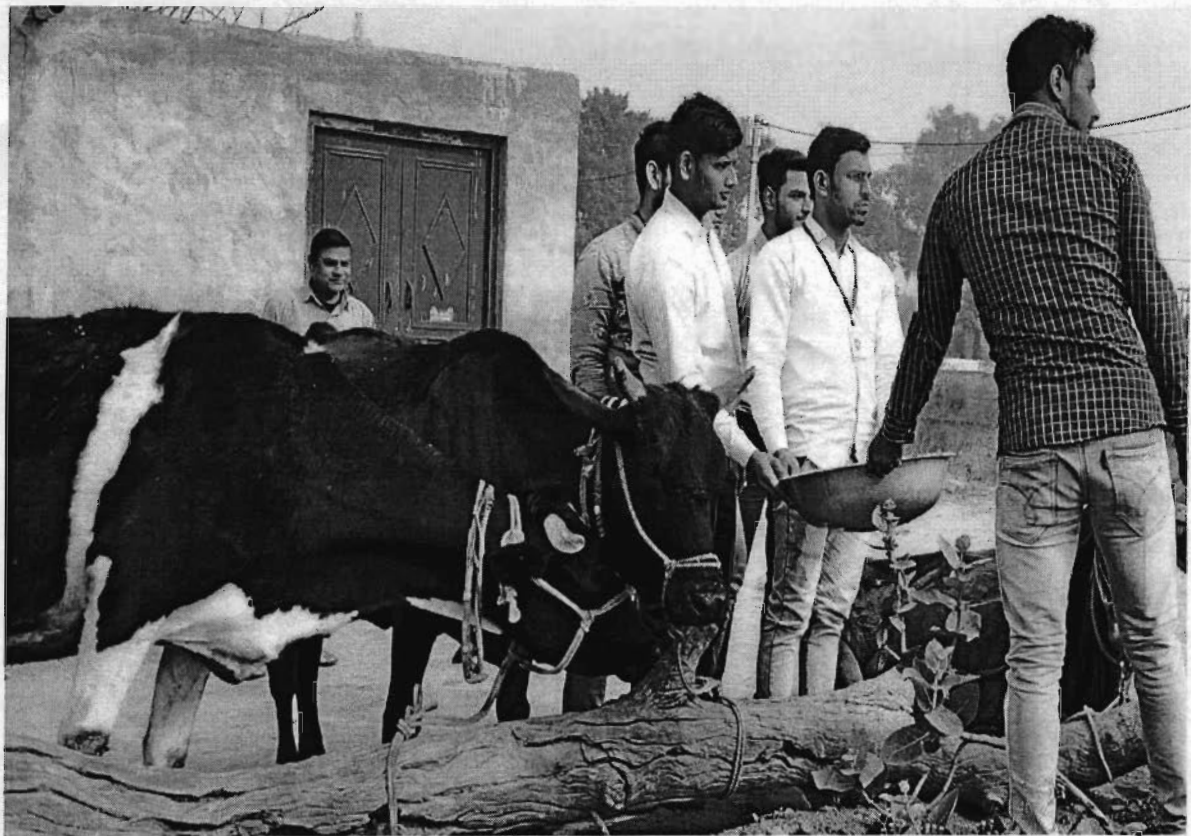
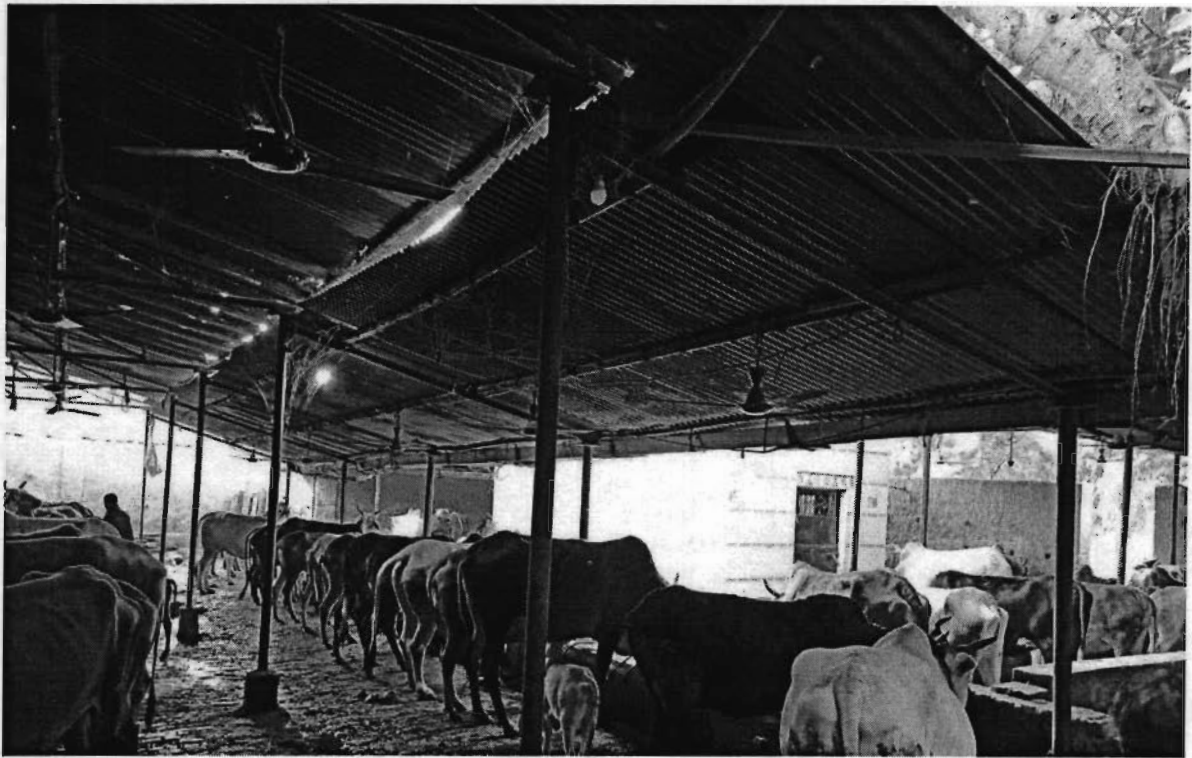

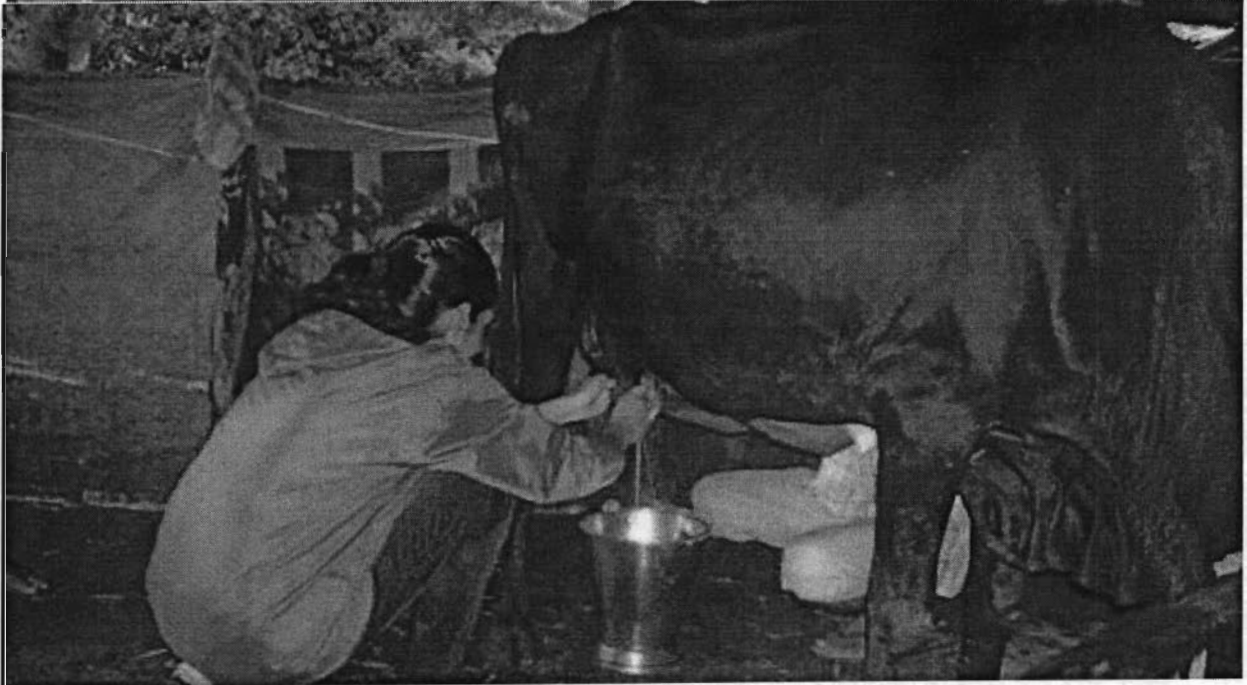
The main aim to organize such an educative visit was to make the students learn about the milching animals, as well as the benefits of dairy products.

They also learnt the medicinal uses and benefits of cow dung and cow urine.

They also learned how the injured and sick cows are taken care of. An entire process of preparing and storing fodder for the cows was also shown to the students and they enjoyed feeding the cows with jaggery and dry fodder. Students were able to get close enough and pet the cows and calf without fear. Along with the cows, students also saw other animals of the farm like geese, dogs and pigs.



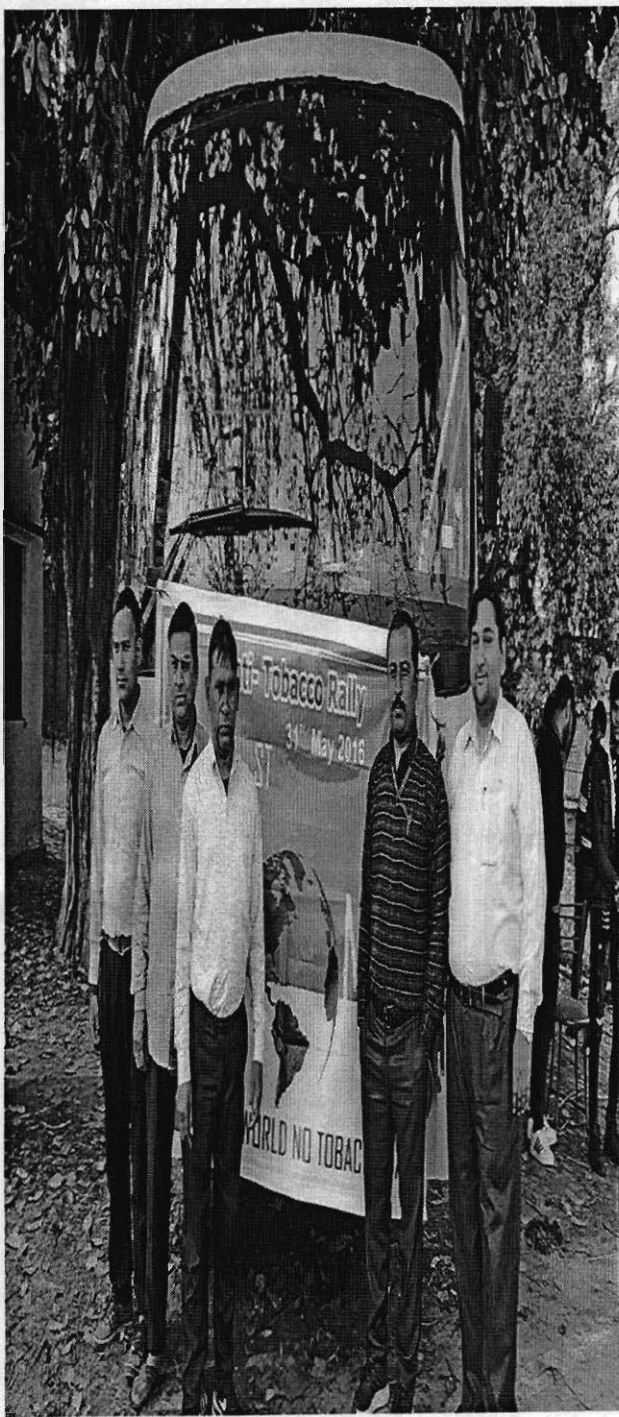
A total of 104 students participated in this awareness rally.

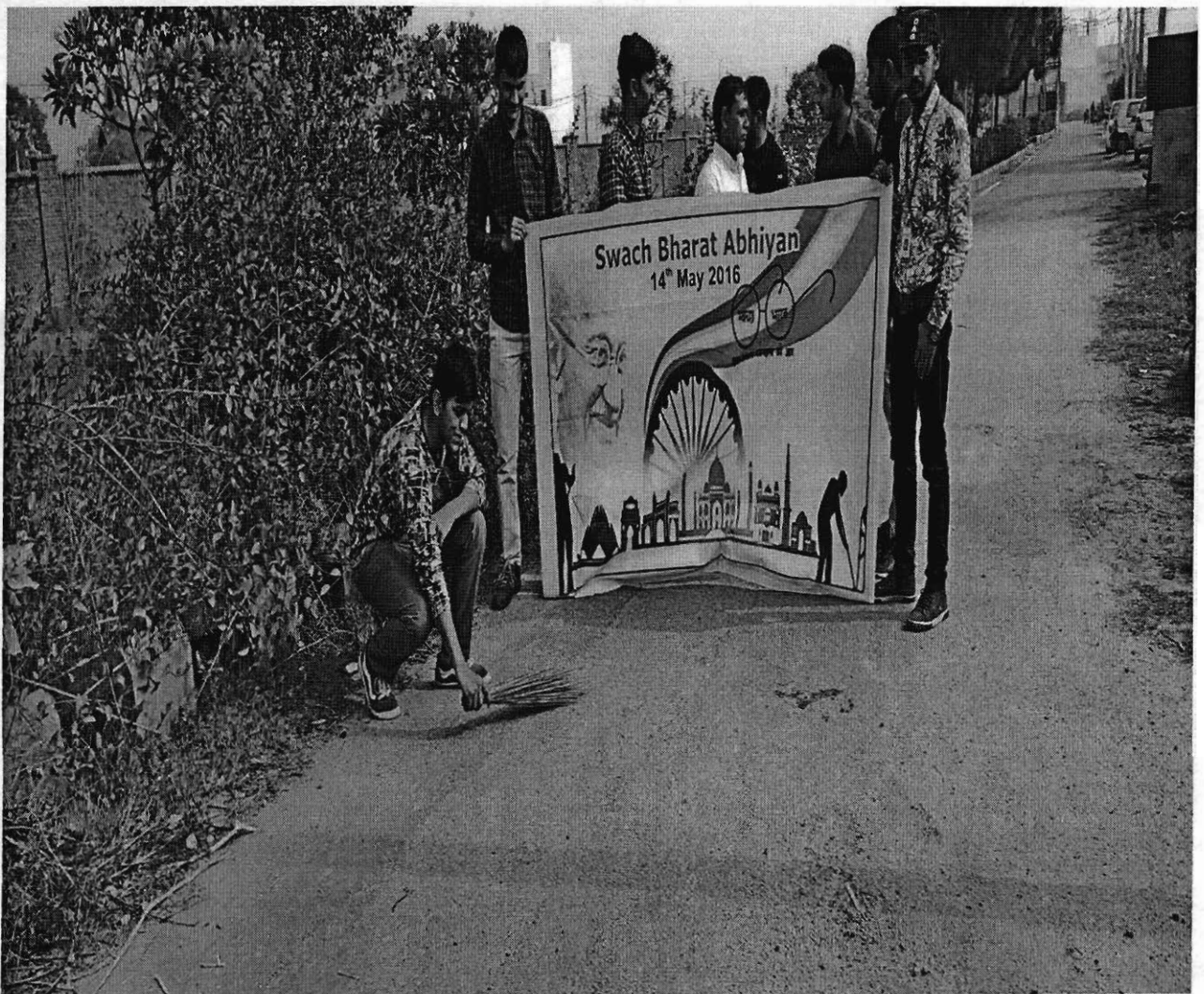

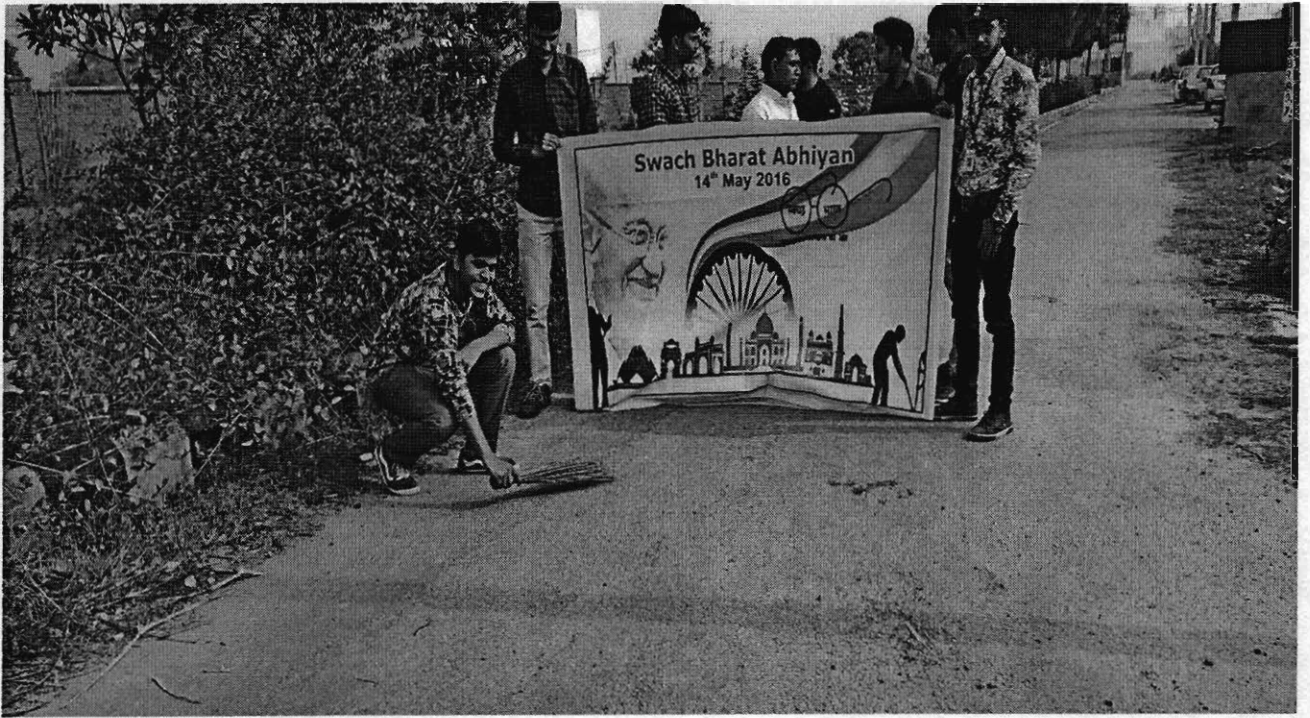

To create awareness among public of nearby villager, students of MIT had initiated an awareness rally with posters and slogans. They also had given handy tips to villagers keep their surroundings clean.

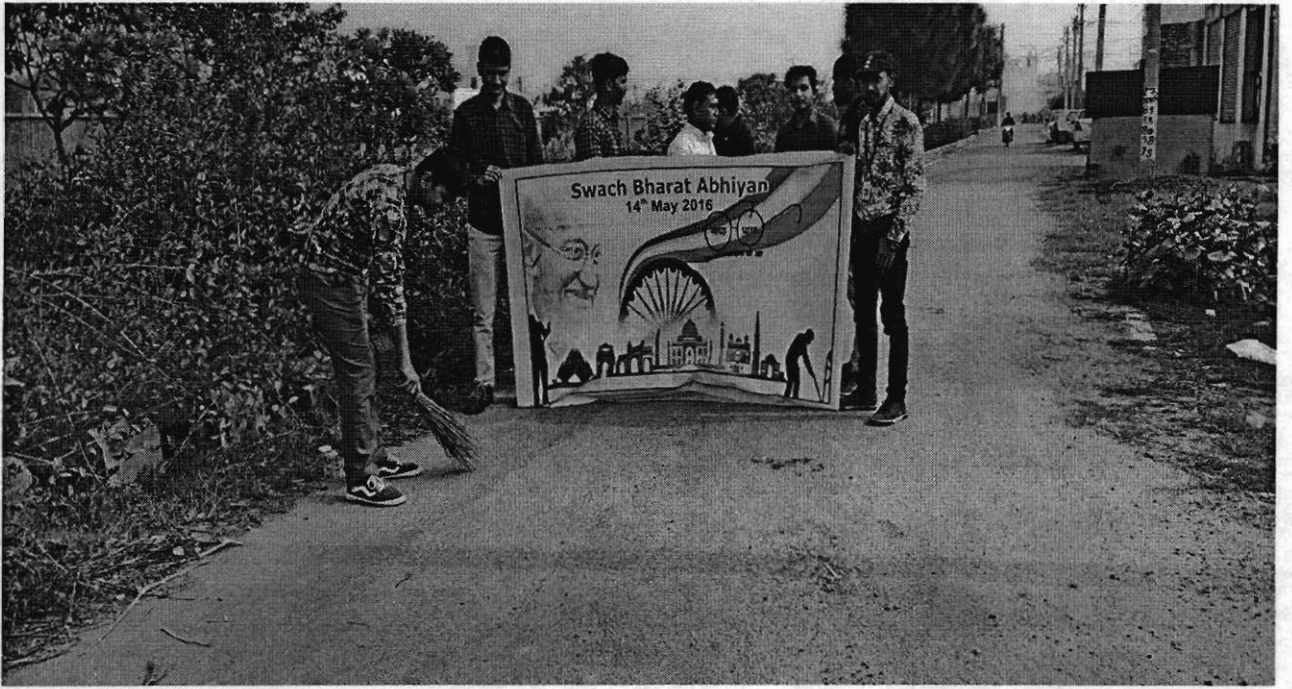
A total of 95 students and staffs enthusiastically took up brooms and garbage bags to clean up every nook and corner grounds, parking lot and nearby areas.

The whole drive was quite inspiring and motivating for the staff and students and village persons in specific and made them aware of the dignity of labor.










